

Daisy Mtn. Rock and Mineral Club Scholarship

The Daisy Mountain Rock and Mineral Club is a non-profit (501-3C) Arizona organization offering a \$1500.00 Geosciences scholarship each calendar year to one qualified graduating high school senior attending BCHS, BGHS, SDOHS. The scholarship is specifically intended to support one student planning to further one's education in the **Geosciences** (geology, geophysics, paleontology, hydrology, oceanography, marine science, atmospheric science, planetary science, meteorology, environmental science, and soil science).



The single \$1500 DMRMC scholarship award will be paid to the appropriate higher learning institution's financial aid office to be applied to the enrolled student's fees. Successful applicants will be required to verify admission and enrollment at a two- or four-year college or university for the following school year.

The scholarship will be awarded without regard to race, sex, religion, age, or national origin. The application deadline for the scholarship in the calendar year 2024 is April 1. The 2024 award will be null and void if the winner is not enrolled in an institution of higher education within one semester of the award. Special circumstances will be reviewed and decided upon by DMRMC membership.

DMRMC SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY AND CRITERIA

1. Applicant must currently be a graduating senior in good standing and attend Boulder Creek High School, Barry Goldwater High School, or Sandra Day O'Connor High School.
2. Applicant must have plans to attend either a 2- or 4-year (not-for-profit) accredited college or university in the Fall of 2024, or Spring of 2025.
3. The student must have an expressed interest in, and a plan to, pursue study in the **Geosciences**.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To be considered for the DMRMC 2024 Scholarship Award of \$1500, applicants must complete and return the application form to DMRMC by April 1, 2024. The application must include:

- A. Completed application form, a picture of yourself, and a copy of your current transcript.
- B. One completed recommendation form, completed by a teacher or school official from the applicant's present school. A family member may NOT fill out the recommendation form. Applicants please note: *fill in the top portions of the DMRMC recommendation form before you forward the form to your reference provider.*

All forms, letters, and related materials must be submitted to DMRMC by hand or postmarked by April 1, 2024 to be considered. DMRMC is not responsible for applications late or lost in the mail.
